This funding will be used to

- 90% of students achieving a C or higher in English
- 90% of students achieving year level reading benchmarks

- 100% of teachers have been observed and given feedback teaching the Bowen Way

Our initiatives include

- Aligning staff professional development to an explicit improvement agenda around the explicit teaching of Reading, Writing and effective pedagogical practices in the classroom
- Continuing to embed coaching to all staff to support an expert teaching team
- Aligning classroom artefacts to the development of assessment literate students Learning Walls,
 Learning Intention/Success Criteria and Quality Teaching & Learning in Maths and English

- School Purchase 2.50 Classroom teacher allocation \$225, 893.25
